An Assembly Service may be purchased separately on any Eaton UPS model sold with a bundled Startup Service.

Please note: The customer is responsible for the delivery of all equipment removal and disposal of existing equipment; providing a suitable equipment environment, including clearances, floor loading and temperature; arranging for a licensed electrician to apply necessary input power and any hardwired output connections; and locating all equipment in the site area where the equipment is to be started.


