In an effort to keep pace with the global information technology landscape, Eaton is announcing the intent to transition from the Eaton Network Card-MS (P/N: NETWORK-MS) to the <u>Eaton Gigabit Network Card</u> (P/N: NETWORK-M2). The Gigabit Network Card, which was released in 2018, brings a host of improvements including gigabit network speeds and UL 2900-2-2 certification for cybersecurity.

Though the legacy NETWORK-MS card will continue to be available for last time buy, Eaton is beginning a planned phase-out of the legacy card in 2019. Customers who standardize on current Eaton UPS models with the NETWORK-MS card should engage with their Eaton sales representative to gain more information about the upcoming transition, including details on transition timing, full Eaton communication options and samples.
